The method is called *The Design for All Test* and has been developed by the Swedish Disability Federation in collaboration with Professor Lena Lorentzen and the division of Design at Mid Sweden University, funded by the governmental Swedish Inheritance Fund.

*The Design for all Test* is used by the Swedish Rheumatism Association to assess how user-friendly products and packages are.
